

Support requests from LKS teams:

Sharing requests for evidence searches between library and knowledge services

To support collaboration between LKS teams, it is now possible for two teams that both serve the same organisation to team up and agree to share search requests from that organisation.

Each LKS should go to their "Edit LKS" page, find the list of organisations they serve, and click "Share Searches" next to the relevant organisation. Having done this, any search request from any member of that organisation will appear in their list of unassigned search requests.



A search can be assigned to staff from either LKS and will be counted for statistic purposes under the LKS team that completes it.
