Future proofing access to KnowledgeShare

As you may know, OpenAthens is changing to ensure that its security measures comply with industry best practice, and KnowledgeShare is developing in parallel with the changes being made.

KnowledgeShare was designed to use the OpenAthens Persistent User ID (PUID) to provide access when a user logs in, but OpenAthens no longer recommends the use of the PUID and now encourages using the more secure pseudonymous user identifier, the Targeted ID (<https://docs.openathens.net/libraries/about-released-attributes>).

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As part of its enhanced security, the Targeted ID can only be shared between computer systems and cannot be manually added to a KnowledgeShare member record.

Work is being done to future-proof the system so that members will be able to access KnowledgeShare when the OpenAthens Persistent User ID (PUID) is no longer available.

Newly added members can use the link in the Welcome to KnowledgeShare email to access the system, which captures the Targeted ID as part of the authentication process. Furthermore, any member who logged in or self-registered on KnowledgeShare since 30 June 2020 will have had their Targeted ID captured in addition to their PUID.

In the meantime, as long as NHS OpenAthens continues to provide a PUID for new OpenAthens members, KnowledgeShare will be able to use this ID on user records to provide access.

The category Telehealth is available to cover an interest in virtual clinics/wards, remote consultations and other online or remote approaches to care delivery.

It sits under Professional Interests, so can be combined with any appropriate Settings category depending where patients would usually be managed (e.g. Rehabilitation Centres for telerehabilitation, General Practice for virtual GP appointments, Outpatients for virtual clinics in secondary care).
