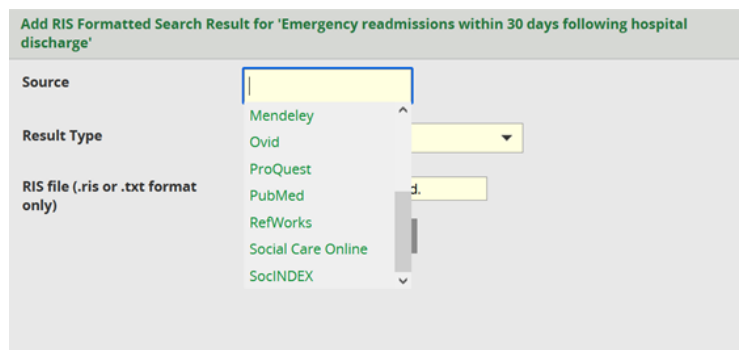

### Importing RIS files from reference management software

You can now choose 'RefWorks' as a Source when adding a RIS file to a KnowledgeShare evidence search.

For more information, see section **4.3.6.8 Exporting RIS files from RefWorks** on page 55 of the [KS Handbook – Evidence](#).

Endnote and Mendeley can also be selected as Sources if you have records in RIS format from these reference managers.



**Tip 1:** If an error message about missing or invalid items is returned when adding a RIS file, you can usually fix the problem by editing the RIS file in Notepad and manually adding any missing tags.

**Tip 2:** A specific problem has been identified with Endnote RIS files. Where a copyright symbol is present in the text of an abstract, the downloaded report from KnowledgeShare is unable to display these abstracts. We are working on a fix but in the meantime you can edit the RIS file in Notepad and remove the symbols using the Find+Replace command (Ctrl+H).

## Category Q&A

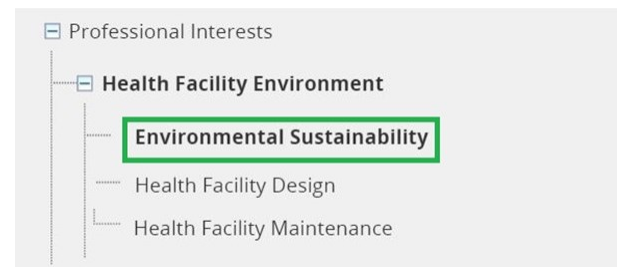


Our members are increasingly showing an interest in green issues in healthcare. What options do we have for defining those interests in their personal interest profiles?
