### Category update May 2025

A significant improvement to our Settings categories is on the way!


Following feedback from mental health librarians we are introducing a new parent category called **Hospital Settings (Mental Health)**, plus four child categories to differentiate from acute hospital settings where staff are focused on physical health conditions.

This should make it much easier to ensure that mental health staff only receive items that are of interest to them.

The change will impact on existing members, so we've provided guidance on actions that all teams need to take. We will soon contact libraries that serve mental health trusts with data to help in updating high priority members.

The change will go live on the evening of **Tuesday 6 May**.

### Evidence Search Result Links

If you use KnowledgeShare to create evidence search reports, you will see that we now generate a LibKey (or NHS Wales LibrarySearch) link for each result.

The link is constructed using the DOI and reads **Check for full-text availability**. It uses the organisation of the person viewing the report to show the relevant page where full-text options are provided. This minimises the number of clicks and login screens for the end user.

The report also includes a **More details** link for each result based on the URL field. If no LibKey / LibrarySearch link can be generated, only the 'More details' link will be shown.

Coming soon: the ability to manually add multiple URLs will be restored.
