Feature reminder: Assigned Librarians

In order to receive update emails or journal alerts, a Member must have an Assigned Librarian. As part of personalised current awareness, updates and journal alerts sent by the system will show this librarian as the sender (via their constructed KnowledgeShare address e.g. rachel.smith@knowledgeshare.nhs.uk).

The Assigned Librarian field is mandatory when staff are adding professional interests for a member, but it will be empty if the member has self-registered or has been transferred from another LKS.

Admins receive an email notification in these cases and must add an Assigned Librarian to the member's record. Even if the member has categories or journal alerts set up, they will not receive anything until they have an assigned librarian. This allows staff to refine category selections before any updates are sent.

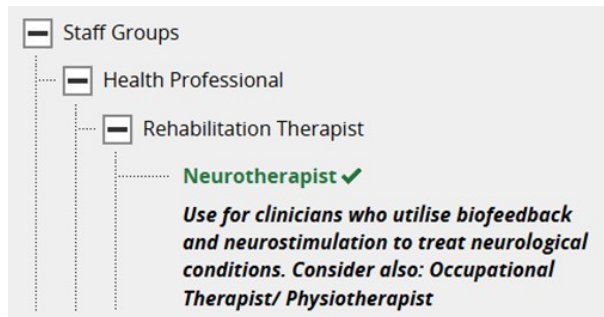

Polycystic Ovary Syndrome has been renamed as **Polyendocrine Metabolic Ovarian Syndrome** in line with the recent consensus published in *The Lancet*.

It remains located under Ovarian Diseases in Women's Health. The former name has been added as an alias to ensure that categorisers can still search and locate it easily.
