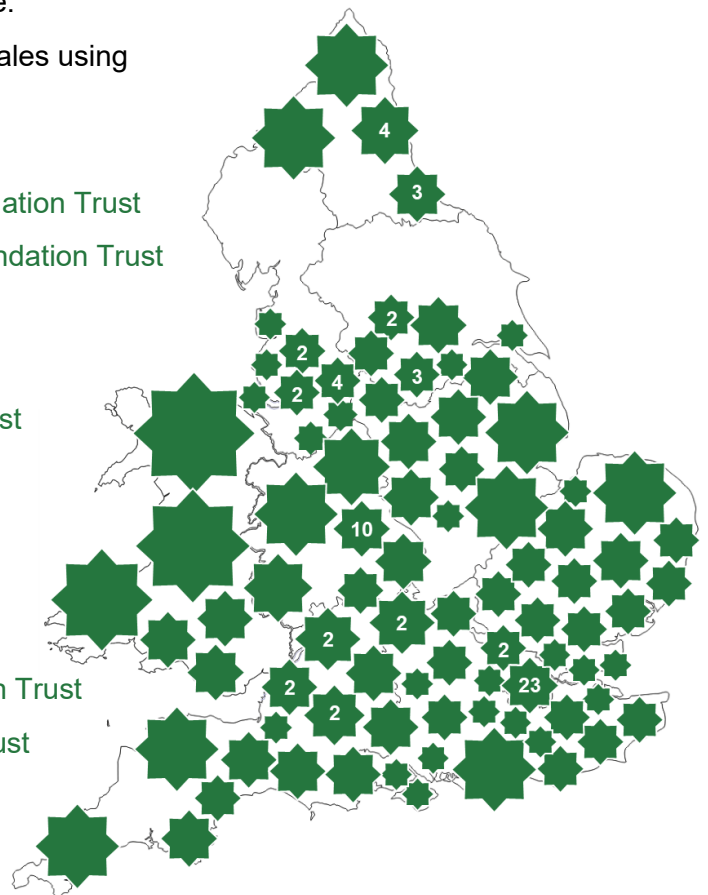


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In November 2020 our map showed more than 100 Library and Knowledge Service teams using KnowledgeShare.
