Changes to intervention-specific categories

We have several intervention-specific categories that sit beneath staff group categories, for example Cognitive Behavioural Therapy and Drug Therapy. These allow a more granular approach to staff group categorisation, however they were implemented as a pilot due to concerns they might disrupt the categorisation model and would therefore need to be evaluated.


Following evaluation, we have determined that where an intervention category sits below one and only one staff group (e.g. Cognitive Behavioural Therapy under Psychologist) they work well.

However, where they sit below two or more staff groups (e.g. Drug Therapy under Medic, Pharmacist and Nurse Specialist) they cause problems. It becomes impossible to target resources solely at nurses versus medics or pharmacists.

Intervention categories will therefore no longer sit below more than one staff group. We will withdraw Drug Therapy from its locations under Medic and Pharmacist, and **categorisers should revert to using Medic or Pharmacist for all staff in these groups**, where an interest in drug therapy will be assumed.

Drug Therapy will remain under Nurse Specialist, to be used for nurses who specifically request updates on this area.

We will edit existing members with these categories before making any changes, so nobody will miss out on relevant resources.




New Category Added: Social Care Support Worker
