**They say "Have a seat in the waiting room".**



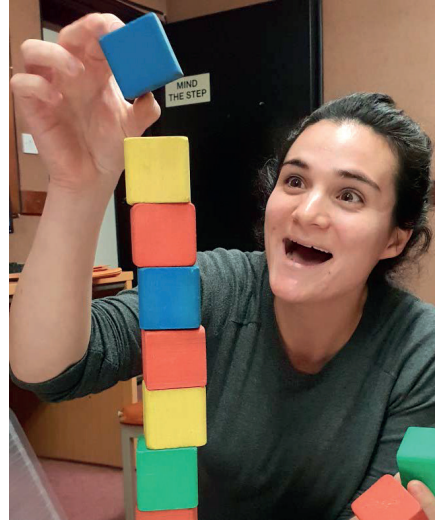
**Then I will go to the Hearing Clinic room.**
