Table of contents (TOC) alerts

KnowledgeShare lets you provide members with regular table of contents (TOC) alerts from journals they request. Only 6% of members currently receive journal alerts, but there is wide variation across the country, with one team providing TOCs to 61% of their members!

How do I set up Journal Alerts for my members?

TOCs are set up from the Journal Alerts section of a member's KnowledgeShare record. Available journals can be selected from the drop-down list. Click 'Add to List' to add a journal to the member's list of alerts they will receive from their Assigned Librarian. All titles currently indexed in PubMed are available and we are looking at expanding to additional titles.

When will the TOCs be sent?

Most TOCs will be sent on the first weekend after the end of the month the articles were published, i.e. an article published in February will be sent on the first weekend in March. There may be exceptions depending when articles are added to PubMed.

How do I promote TOCs to my members?

We recommend adding an option to your KnowledgeShare sign-up form or library membership form.
