

How do I ensure obstetricians and midwives receive resources about a condition in pregnancy, but don't receive resources about the same condition in the non-pregnant population?



In most cases, it's better to choose only from the Pregnancy and Childbirth section of the category tree for the member's categories, and omit conditions in other areas.

This is because a resource on, for example, headaches during pregnancy, will be categorised with pregnancy categories as well as Headache. Therefore a member with pregnancy-related categories would not miss out on it, but if they had the category Headache they would also receive less relevant resources, unrelated to pregnancy.

Some specific complications of pregnancy also have their own categories, e.g. Gestational Diabetes, Pregnancy Induced Hypertension, and Haematologic Pregnancy Complications (e.g. anaemia).

New and updated categories

Legionellosis. Commonly known as Legionnaires' Disease. (Under Communicable Diseases> Bacterial Diseases)

Medical Errors. Renamed from “Medication Errors” to include medication errors, diagnostic errors and surgical errors. (Under Professional Interests> Quality, Safety & Risk> Patient Safety)

Metabolic Dysfunction-Associated Steatotic Liver Disease. Renamed from “Non-Alcoholic Fatty Liver Disease” (Under Digestive System Diseases> Liver Diseases)

Peritonitis. (Under Digestive System Diseases> Gastroenteritis)

Physiologist. Healthcare Scientist who works directly with patients using specialist equipment to conduct tests and guide treatment. Use in combination with the relevant specialty: e.g., Cardiovascular Diseases (Under Staff Groups> Scientist/ Technician)

Vaginal Fistula. (Under Women's Health> Vaginal Diseases)
