**Audit, Quality Improvement Presentations, and Case Based Discussions - Part one**  
Hosted by: ESHT, SASH, SCFT and UHSussex

#### Target audience

This is the sixth of a series of virtual once-monthly training events for Trainee Pharmacists working within secondary care in Sussex and parts of Surrey undertaking a rotation, or multisector programme in another sector. Through this programme, we aim to promote a culture of multi-sectoral working to support the safe transfer of medicines across primary and secondary care.

We have developed this session to provide an opportunity for you to showcase your work to fellow trainees and the Education and Development teams. We also have used this opportunity to provide formative feedback/assessment of the highest quality to enable our trainees and newly qualified workforce to continuously strive for improvement and innovation in Pharmacy. This year we have seen an incredible range of topics across community, primary and secondary care and your hard work is invaluable to this. Your presentations will be reviewed by panel members who will provide you tailored feedback on your projects and your Project Supervisors will also all be invited to attend the session.

Following on from your hard work, we will also discuss the opportunity to submit your work to Pharmacy Clinical Congress, RPS, UKCPA and the Pharmacy Sussex Conference for 2026. During this presentation session, we will have representatives from the University of Brighton present to talk about further research opportunities, leading on to the next steps for you once you qualify in Sussex and Surrey.

We have also combined the event with case based discussion presentations enabling some of the trainee pharmacists to share their clinical contributions to patient care with others.
